2019 PULLING SEASON RULE CHANGES

PI MOTORSPORTS EXECUTIVE BOARD

1. Page 2 #2 Modify Rule
All board members representing one of the 8 classes will serve a 2-year term. The office of President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer will be a 4-year term.
2. Page 2 #5 Modify Rule
The board positions of President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer will be elected by the voting members at the annual general meeting.

OPEN STOCK TRUCKS

1. Page 21 #7 Engine Clarifying current rule – no dating for 3 years
Factory stock cooling and charging system, single fuel pump, battery and fuel tanks in stock location or metal fuel tank or cell mounted in box with steel or **steel** braided lines. Battery operated ignitions.

MIXED CLASS

1. No changes.

SUPER STOCK TRUCKS

1. Page 11 #2 Engine *Tabled for Automatic Vote in 2019*
Head Rule Change. Scott Kieckbusch will need to resubmit for 2019.

HOT FARM 466 TRACTORS

1. Page 29 #7 Engine Addition to current rule.
Only one turbo allowed. **Turbo will be checked and certified on both sides and then sealed.**

DIESEL 2.5 TRUCKS

1. Change to 2.5 slotted or 2.6 smooth bore *Tabled for Automatic Vote in 2019*
Ty Davies & Zach Perzinski will need to resubmit exact proposed changes for 2019.

MOD 4X4 TRUCKS

1. Payout Change One-year trial basis
Lower class price from \$2150 / 10 places to \$1800 / 7 places

SUPER FARM TRACTORS

1. No Changes

PRO FARM TRACTORS

1. Page 26 #2 Body Clarifying current rule – no dating for 3 years
Steel flywheel **and** safety blanket required.
2. Page 26 #4 Engine Modify Rule
640 cubic inch limit with a plus or minus of 1% variance. **Maximum of 1" deck plate allowed.**
