2018 PULLING SEASON RULE CHANGES

PI MOTORSPORTS GENERAL RULES

1. Page 10 #67 Add Rule
Sled can be repositioned. Driver or appointed person by the driver can move the cone or stand in place before the sled is back to starting point.

OPEN STOCK TRUCKS

1. Page 21 #3 Engine Clarifying current rule – no dating for 3 years
Factory produced cast iron head allowed with verifiable numbers. Numbers will be checked at tech time. Owner is responsible to take it a part to show the numbers.

MIXED CLASS

1. All rules approved that were on a one-year trial basis in 2017.

SUPER STOCK TRUCKS

1. Page 11 #3 Body Addition to current rule
Any hood scoop allowed. Base of carburetor must be below hood line. Air cleaner may protrude thru hood with maximum of 4" sides front and rear.

HOT FARM 466 TRACTORS

1. Page 28 #2 Engine Remove rule
~~No engine of original manufacturer of large cubic inched may be de-cubed.~~
2. Page 31 #4 Weight One-year trial basis in 2017 – Approved for 2018
All tractors will be certified at the first pull of the season. A three-tractor average will be used for future certifications. Certified weights will be recorded by tech officials.
3. Page 29 #4 Engine (#3-2018) One-year trial basis in 2017 – Revised for 2018
Testing of tractors will be done at each event. Three pullers will be chosen at random at the conclusion of registration by the registration person or head tech official. These 2 tractors will be tested for either water, turbo size or fuel immediately after the class is done pulling. Water must freeze consistently after 4 hours in the freezer against a clean water standard sample. Fuel should not burn when ignited with a lighter. Turbo intake with 3.050" slug. If any criteria are not met, puller is disqualified for that pull with no money or point awarded.
4. Page 30 #13 Engine (#12-2018) Addition to current rule from Engine #4
Tractors pulled once <3000 RPM. Tractors pulled two or more times <3030 RPM.
